



PLANS: A pilot scheme will see the Ormeau Road reduced to one lane of traffic on specified days this month

## PILOT FOR ORMEAU ROAD

*One lane of traffic on certain days in August*

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A NEW pilot scheme will see the Ormeau Road reduced to one lane of traffic on specified days during August.

It comes as organisers of the Open Ormeau initiative

dropped plans to close the busy arterial road to traffic.

The project was put forward to try and provide more space for walking, queuing, socialising and expanding bars, restaurants and cafes out into the road in the light of Covid-19 restrictions.

The final proposal, which was approved by Belfast City Council's Strategic Policy and Resources Committee says the Ormeau Road will remain open to through traffic at 'all times'.

Traffic, however, will also be reduced to one lane of

through-traffic in each direction with lanes designated as cycle priority and a 10pmh speed limit in place during trial periods.

The proposal also states that the initial road closure idea did not receive the backing of businesses who did

not believe any increase in people arriving by foot, bicycle or public transport would 'adequately' make up for lost trade from customers arriving by car.

Hours for the proposal have also been reduced.
