CALLS FOR VIOLENCE TO STOP

13-year-old arrested after rioting in Sandy Row

THERE have been calls for the violence – that has engulfed parts of Belfast in the past week – to come to an end.

South Belfast Alliance MLA Paula Bradshaw has also appealed for leadership from

politicians and community workers to stop a repeat of the violent scenes that took place in Sandy Row last Friday night. There has also been rioting in the North and West of the city over the past week.

In Sandy Row petrol bombs, fireworks, bricks and bottles

were thrown at police, with eight officers injured.

The PSNI said eight people were arrested. Three teenage boys aged 13, 14 and 17 have since been charged. Three men and a woman have also been charged, while another man has been released on bail

pending further enquiries.

“Those engaged in rioting have achieved nothing other than bringing misery upon their own area, including the potential for criminal records harming future prospects,” said Ms Bradshaw.

“There is no future in this

type of behaviour.

“Our thoughts must also be with the police officers who were injured.

“Public servants have a fundamental right to go to and return from work without being targets.”
