Bradshaw says expanding Carryduff area must be included in future route

THE growing Carryduff area must be included on the route

of the new Glider service planned for South Belfast.

That's the belief of South Belfast MLA Paula Bradshaw, who was speaking after a consultation on the second phase of the plan to link South and North Belfast by Glider was launched this week.

Ms Bradshaw welcomed the consultation but rejected the assessment of the Glider plan

that the service should not continue to the Carryduff roundabout because of low levels of residential density.

Local Government Boundaries Commissioner Sarah Havlin has published her provisional Eccal Government Bothdaires Collimisation and analysis and make recommendations. The Commissioner's task is to review and make recommendations in respect of the number, boundaries and names of the 11 local government districts and the number, boundaries and names of the wards into which each district is divided, in line with the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1972.

There will now be an 8 week period of public consultation. The closing date for written representations is 21st September 2021. Following this period, a series of public hearings will be held, one for each District. Further details of these will be available in due course


