UNI STAFF STRIKE AGAIN

Hopes of a settlement as the long-running dispute sees its third day of action

STAFF at Queen’s and Ulster universities came out on strike

again on Wednesday in the last of their planned three days of action in pursuit of fair pay and better conditions.

The local uni staff joined colleagues from 58 higher education institutions across the UK in protest at a 3 per

cent pay increase offer. Dr Rebecca Bamford, a senior lecturer at Queen’s, says there are hopes of a

breakthrough after negotiators met with the representatives of universities in London.

She said the picket at Queen’s had been “hugely well attended.”
