BOYNE BRIDGE GONE

Sandy Row opposition not enough to save historic landmark from wrecking ball

THE historic Boyne Bridge in South Belfast has finally been

demolished after delays caused by passionate local opposition and planning issues.

The bridge finally faded into the history books this week as work continues apace on road developments connected to

the adjacent new Grand Central Station.

Translink has promised that significant parts of the

structure of the bridge – an important part of Orange culture given its links to King William – will be retained for

future heritage projects. The work is due to be completed by the end of the year.
